Peter Hartrey's talk and slide show this year will be taking us to:

## The Kuari Pass and The Valley of Flowers.

"The historic Kuari Pass lies on the approach route to two of India's highest mountains, Nanda Devi and Kamet, both of which were eventually climbed by British mountaineers in the 1930s.

The expedition which climbed Kamet in 1931 returned by a different route, crossing a high pass and descending into the head of the Bhyundar Valley. The team were struck by the beauty and abundance of flowers they found there. In 1937 the leader, Frank Smythe, finally had the chance to return there, staying for four months and writing a book afterwards titled The Valley of Flowers. To this day the upper part of the Bhyundar Valley is still known by this name. It is now a World Heritage Site."

### DOWNYOUR WAY - Wrelton as it was!


